

Hear More About The Kemptown Substation

Public Information Meeting

The Potomac Edison Company, an Allegheny Energy affiliate, will share plans for the proposed Kemptown Substation along Bartholows Road, south of I-70 near Kemptown in Frederick County. As part of the Potomac-Appalachian Transmission Highline (PATH) project, the Kemptown Substation will support the power needs of our region and avoid electric reliability issues projected to occur by mid-2015.

At the meeting, members of the community can learn more about why the substation is needed, where it will be located, the timetable and what it will look like when completed.
